Playtime Snacks

Diocesan Building Fund

Many thanks for your generous contributions to this very important fund – so far they total £ 690.

Our optimum figure is £3195 so we are still £2505 short. As I've previously explained, all Parents are asked to contribute something to this fund to enable us to improve and refurbish our school building. Please remember Catholic Schools receive only 90% funding for building works whereas County Schools receive 100% funding.

This fund has allowed us to refurbish our Lower KS2 toilets, update our heating system, replace part of our roof at no cost whatsoever to our budget as we received a 90% grant for the works and the Diocesan Building Fund paid the remaining 10%. We have put in bids to complete the roof replacement and refurbish our Upper KS2 toilets so, if we are successful, we will be dependent, yet again, on support from the Diocesan Building Fund to fully fund the work. The Diocese request a voluntary contribution of £15 per child per year and each school is given a target income based on the number on role. When the income from parents falls short of the target the school has to make up the difference from its own budget thus reducing money that goes directly to the children. Please do make a contribution, no matter how small.
